




















This program **IS** for you

- For doctoral students (3rd year and above) and postdocs
- Individual coaching session
- 1 year

Application windows for this year already closed. In 2024 no mentoring offerings.

Peer Mentoring

- Group of persons (peers) constitute themselves as group
- 2-5 senior mentors (from academia or industry) assist the group selectively
- For doctoral students and postdocs
- Set a career-relevant topic on which the group wants to work
- Group organises workshops with trainers
- Budget of CHF 5000
- 1 year
